The members discussed the following communication received from regulatory authorities like AICTE, AP Government, etc.

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i) Extension of Approval / Increase in Intake / Introduction of New Courses / Closure of courses by AICTE:

The AICTE, New Delhi, vide its letter F.No.South-Central/1-4266244881/ 2019/ EOA, dated 29th April 2019 has extended approval for all the existing programs for the academic year 2019-20, reduction in intake of B.Tech EEE from 180 to 120 and change of name of M.Tech course in Embedded Systems as VLSI Design and Embedded Systems with an intake of 24.

ii) Lateral Entry admissions reduce from 20% to 10%

As per AICTE Approval Process Hand Book 2019-20, the AICTE reduce the Lateral Entry admission from 20% to 10% in APH 2019-20, Chapter VI, Point 6.9. The details as given below:

6.9 Admission to Lateral Entry to Second Year Course(s)

- a. Lateral Entry to Second Year Diploma Course(s) shall be permissible up to a maximum of 10% of the “Approved Intake” which shall be over and above, supernumerary to the “Approved Intake”, plus the unfilled vacancies of the First year as specified in the Approval Process Handbook.
- b. Lateral Entry to Second Year Degree Course(s) in Engineering and Technology/ Pharmacy/ MCA Programme shall be permissible up to a maximum of 10% of the “Approved Intake” which shall be over and above, supernumerary to the “Approved Intake”, plus the unfilled vacancies of the First year as specified in the Approval Process Handbook.

iii) Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) : G.O.Ms.No.39, dated 30-07-2019

In accordance with the provisions of the Constitution (One hundred and third Amendment) Act, 2019, and the reference of Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment vide O.MNo.20013/01/2018-BC-II, Dated:17.1.2019, enabling provisions of reservations for the **Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs)** who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservations for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes it has been decided to provide reservation in admission to educational institutions subject to a maximum of ten percent of the total seats in each category. This would not apply to the minority education institutions referred to in clause (1) of Article 30 of the Constitution of India.

36.14 To discuss about the introduction of new courses / closures of some of the existing courses / variation of intake in the existing courses during the academic year 2020-21.

Resolution: It is resolved to submit the application to AICTE for

- i) reduction in intake of B.Tech course in Civil Engineering from 180 to 120,
- ii) increase in intake of B.Tech course in Information Technology from 120 to 180
- iii) introduction of new course: B.Tech – Data Science (or) Artificial Intelligence to be offered by the department of Computer Science and Engineering, and
- iv) reduction in intake of all M.Tech courses i.e. Structural Engineering, Power Electronics and Electric Drives, Machine Design, VLSI Design and Embedded Systems and Computer Science and Engineering from 24 to 18.

from the academic year 2020-21 along with the application for extension of approval.
