- iv) reduction in intake of all M.Tech courses i.e. Structural Engineering, Power Electronics and Electric Drives, Machine Design, VLSI Design and Embedded Systems and Computer Science and Engineering from 24 to 18

the academic year 2020-21 along with the application for extension of approval.

**Action Taken:** Application to be submitted to AICTE for extension of approval for the academic year 2020-21.

- reduction in intake of all M.Tech courses i.e. Structural Engineering, Power Electronics and Electric Drives, Machine Design, VLSI Design and Embedded Systems and Computer Science and Engineering from 24 to 18.

from the academic year 2020-21 along with the application for extension of approval.

37.11 Review of preparation for NBA visit scheduled from 27<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> December 2019.

The Principal presented the preparations for NBA visit scheduled during 27 – 29 December 2019.

#### 37.12 Any other item with the permission of the chair.

a. Delegation of the financial powers to Principal and Heads of the Departments

To delegate financial powers to the Heads of the Departments not exceeding Rs.5,000/- at a time subject to a maximum amount of Rs.25,000/- per semester.

To delegate financial powers to the Principal not exceeding Rs.25,000/- at a time subject to a maximum amount of Rs.2,00,000/- per semester.

**Resolution**: It is unanimously resolved, and also issued proceedings to the Principal for financial powers to Principal and Heads of the Departments.

b. To present the communication from the Promoter society related to irrevocably allocating and earmarking of 1.79 acres including the constructed building to Gudlavalleru Engineering College.

115.06: AANM & VVRSR Educational Society applied for the approval of Building plans to establish Musunuri Venkata Rama Rao Institute of Business Management in 2008, obtained approval and constructed the Buildings. AICTE accorded permission to establish this Institute vide its letter F.No.SCRO/2010/1-9369311, dated 14-07-2010. Because of lack of admissions, Promoter Society applied to AICTE for the closure of the Institution and closed the Institution with the approval of the AICTE vide its letter No.South-Central/1-747480994/2012/Closure, Dated 07th June 2012. With this, those assets are no longer required to be earmarked for the institution and have become the society's assets. V. Nagesvan Kod

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Subsequently, Promoter Society earmarked that 1.79 acres of area in R.S.No.46 of Gudlavalleru Gram Panchayat with the constructed building (about 57,000 sft.) for Gudlavalleru Engineering College. The expenditure incurred by the society for the said college has been paid by Gudlavalleru Engineering College to the society on 30-04-2017. With this payment, the society is required to irrevocably allocate and earmark that land and that building to Gudlavalleru Engineering College.

Resolution: It is unanimously resolved to irrevocably allocate and earmark the area of 1.79 acres including the building constructed (about 57,000 sft) in it to Gudlavalleru Engineering College and also to register this resolution with the registering authority.

**Resolution**: Governing Body has unanimously resolved to accept that and advises the Secretary and Correspondent and the Principal to initiate necessary steps and complete the process at the earliest.

c. To discuss on utilization of contingency fund for salaries payment purpose. As per the Governing Body resolution 28.11, contingency fund is to be used to meet the non-recurring expenditure requirements of the institution.

**Resolution:** In view of the present necessities, it is resolved to use these funds temporarily for salaries payment purpose on loan basis. This resolution is applicable till next GB meeting and the ex-officio member secretary is advised to present a report on this at every GB meeting for a review and an appropriate decision.
